

COMPOSTING

What do we do with all that debris?

Between landscaping yard waste, fall leaf removal, and damage from snow and ice storms here in the Pacific Northwest, we've got lots of organic debris on our hands! But what happens to all of it after cleanup? *We recycle it back into nature, of course!*

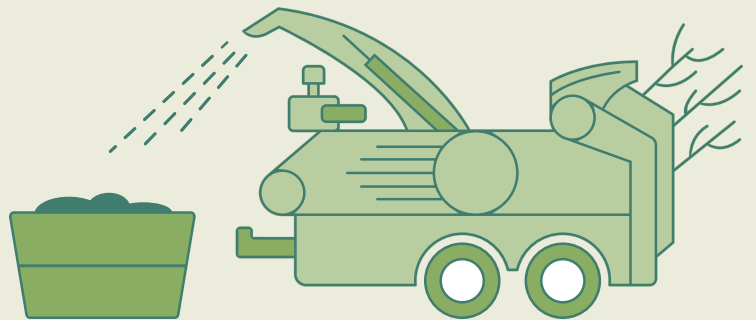
STEP 1. Gather

Grass clippings and debris from shrubs and trees are gathered at landscaping job sites, brought back to our headquarters by the crews, and dumped into a debris bin.



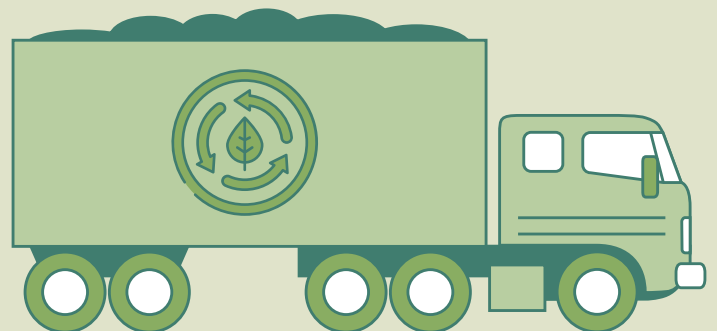
STEP 2. Grind

Next, all of the debris is grinded into small particles with our large tub grinder.



STEP 3. Transform

Once we produce enough grindings, they are sent to a company who rotates them until they turn into compost.



STEP 4. Plant

The compost is then returned back to us. From there, we deliver it to commercial and residential job sites where it is mixed with soil to create a planting medium for establishing new trees, shrubs, and lawns!
